## What Can I Do With a Major in Sociology/Anthropology?

Sociology and anthropology are often considered sister disciplines, with much in common. Sociologists tend to focus on society--conceptualized in terms of social relations and social structures--whereas anthropologists tend to focus on culture, on systems of meaning. In reality, there is much overlap. The study of criminal justice draws on perspectives and tools from both sociology and anthropology to analyze a particular aspect of society and culture--notably crime and justice.

Employment opportunities exist for Sociology/Anthropology majors in a wide variety of areas including government, business, law, politics, social service, and education.

Students are also prepared to pursue graduate coursework in law or public policy as well as many other Political Science related disciplines. If a graduate with a Bachelor's degree is looking for employment after graduation, opportunities exist at the managerial level in county, state, and federal agencies and with research centers concerned with domestic and international issues, policies and practices.
